What is NEO ?

NEO is an e-learning platform dedicated to training new entrants at Inserm. It fulfills the regulatory requirement for training in the prevention of occupational risks.

Who is concerned by NEO ?

All new entrants to Inserm, regardless of their status (permanent staff, contract staff, students, or interns), are required to complete this training. The platform can be accessed at <https://neo.inserm.fr>

How does NEO work ?

- **Training modules** : Each module lasts about 40 minutes and alternates between theoretical sequences and interactive activities. The topics covered include:
 - ✓ Prevention
 - ✓ Fire risk
 - ✓ Chemical risk
 - ✓ Biological risk
- **Knowledge validation** : At the end of each module, a multiple-choice quiz allows learners to validate their acquired knowledge.
- **Certificate** : A training certificate is issued upon completion of the program.

What are the roles of those involved in NEO ?

- **The entrant** : Commits to completing the training and validating all modules.
- **The local NEO administrator / prevention assistant** : Customizes the training path, monitors progress, and issues the certificate after it has been signed by management.

The NEO training is mandatory and must be completed as soon as possible after starting the position.
