



Certibiocide disinfectants

As of 1 January 2026, any person who selects, purchases, distributes, or uses **professional biocidal disinfectants must hold the Certibiocide (disinfectants) certification.**

Without this certificate, the purchase and use of these products will no longer be legally permitted.

The **Certibiocide** is a **mandatory individual certification** attesting to completion of regulatory training for the safe and compliant use of biocides:

- **TP2:** disinfection of surfaces, premises, and equipment
- **TP3:** veterinary hygiene
- **TP4:** surfaces in contact with food

The **Certibiocide** aims to:

- Reduce health risks associated with the use of biocidal products (chemical exposure, irritation, poisoning)
- Limit environmental impact (water and soil pollution, toxicity to fauna and flora)
- Ensure rational use in compliance with health and regulatory standards

The certificate is obtained after **two half-days of training**. It is **personal** and **valid for 5 years**.
